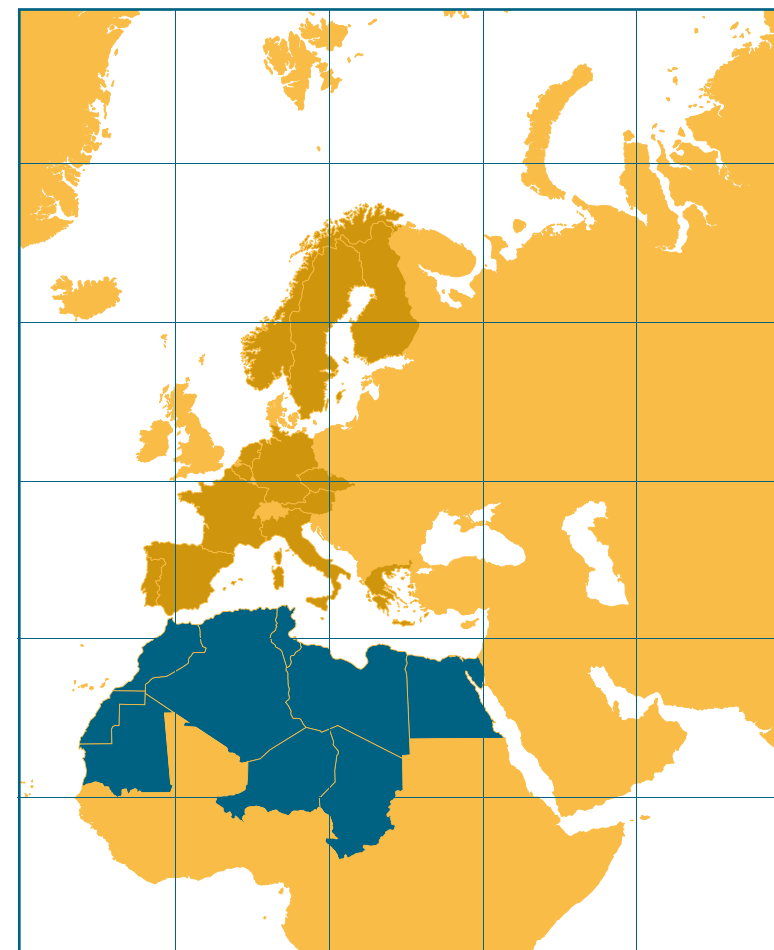
# PHASE 1-5

supports 57 projects by CEFA ▲ COOPI ▲ IOM ▲ Save The Children Italy ▲ StARS ▲ UNHCR ▲ UNICEF.

RDPP-NA has funded **57 projects** in **Algeria, Chad, Egypt, Libya, Mauritania, Morocco, Niger and Tunisia** for an overall budget of € 63,7 million euros. The projects are implemented by IOM, Save The Children Italy, UNICEF, CEFA, COOPI, StARS and UNHCR.

### Main supported activities (priorities indicated annually by DG HOME and approved by the Consortium):

- ◆ **Assisted Voluntary Return and Reintegration** to the countries of origin
- ◆ **Awareness raising** activities on the risks related to irregular migration and access to international protection.
- ◆ **Capacity building** initiatives in support of national Governments, NGOs and civil society organizations with a specific focus on human rights standards, international protection and services for vulnerable migrants and refugees
- ◆ **Child Protection** for children on the move.
- ◆ **Direct Assistance** for migrants and refugees, including: distribution of food and non-food items, medical, legal and psychosocial assistance.
- ◆ **Infrastructure Works** for rehabilitation and equipment of key facilities.
- ◆ **Registration, Refugee Status Determination and Durable Solutions** for asylum-seekers and refugees.

### Areas of Intervention

#### Assisted Voluntary Return and Reintegration

**3.2K** **vulnerable migrants** identified, referred or assisted in the return to their country of origin including the facilitation of the acquisition of emergency travel documents; received through reintegration or community-based assistance; and reached through the AVRR information campaign and counselling sessions.

#### Awareness Raising Campaign

**122K** **vulnerable migrants and refugees** reached through outreach activities to inform about available assistance, safe migration, and asylum information.

#### Capacity Building

**5.1K** **officials, civil society actors, and volunteers** trained on international laws, mixed migration flow management, migrant rights, and law enforcement.

**10** **tools and procedures** developed for the identification, referral and protection of vulnerable migrants and children in transit.

#### Child Protection

**492** **service providers** trained on child case management and/or support for children on the move.

**51K** **children** reunified with their families or placed in family-based care or appropriate alternative services, received assistance or protective service, or placed in learning programs.

**3** **tools and procedures** developed for legal processes of the identification, certification and monitoring of foster families, and for the placement of children.

**2.8K** **cases/assessments** of best interest for children conducted.

#### Direct Assistance

**128K** **migrants and refugees** received accommodations, food, non-food items, or tailored protection assistance.

#### Infrastructure Works

**42** **key facilities** rehabilitated, constructed or equipped.

#### Registration, RSD and Resettlement

**152K** **cases/assessments** RSD decisions finalized from Jan 2016 - June 2021 (UNHCR Data Finder).

**272K** **individuals** newly registered from 2016 - 2021.
