
Enhancing efforts to identify victims and ensuring that they receive the necessary assistance, support and protection.

In year 2014 Slovak republic secured the connection to ICSE database and seven officers of Cybercrime unit and one officer of Interpol Bratislava was successfully trained for ICSE database usage.

Operational Goal: Establish the necessary framework for the criminalization of child sexual abuse online and the effective prosecution of offenders, with the objective of enhancing efforts to investigate and prosecute offenders.

In connection to current negative situation and also to implementation of the Directive 2011/92/EU regarding children protection level was revised Penal Code and regarding CSE and CAM new articles § 201a, § 201b and § 370 were added to Penal Code and articles §87, §127, §132, §202, §367 and §370 were changed (effective from 1st August 2013).

After about a year of operation with revised Penal Code progress regarding criminalization of child sexual abuse online we can assess as very positive.

<u>Operational Goal</u>: Develop, improve, or support appropriate public awareness campaigns or other measures which educate parents, children, and others responsible for children regarding the risks that children's online conduct poses and the steps they can take to minimize those risks.

Police Force of the Slovak republic participates in community-based prevention program "Safer Internet" with civil society eSlovensko under the auspices of UNICEF which is focused on protecting children and young people on the Internet. The program include projects Zodpovedne.sk, Pomoc.sk and Stopline.sk.

Their main objectives are:

- establishment and operation of the National Awareness Centre Zodpovedne.sk, which is devoted to the following list of risks the Internet mobile communications and new technologies, pedophilia, pornography, cyberbullying, racism, xenophobia, self-injury, violence, grooming, sharing of personal data and Internet frauds
- raising of awareness and responsible use of the Internet, mobile communications and new technologies, prevention of crimes,
- ensuring and operating of the helpline Pomoc.sk,
- participation in international networks, sharing the experiences of other national centers and organizations for IT security,
- establish and operate a national center for reporting illegal content and activities on the Internet Stopline.sk.

Part of the activities in the area of child protection is a project OVCE.sk. Animated series and internet portal was created as a part of the project Zodpovedne.sk. The aim of fairy tales is spread awareness about the risks of the Internet, mobile phones and new technologies. For the lower age category of children wants to act as a series of prevention, to youth age category wants to mirror their inappropriate behavior on the Internet and to adult audiences have tales to learn and have fun.

The target groups of the projects are not only children but also teachers, parents, preventers and other people working with children. It is obvious that each group must be solved in another way and for this reason a number of tools have been developed to achieve the objective - to teach children how to use the internet and mobile phones responsibly .

All projects will operating continuously from its inception until today.
