Description of the actions already undertaken	-Cambodia has Policy and Minimum Standard on the Protection of the Rights of and assistance of Victims of Trafficking and other crimes. As resources to the identification of victims of this crime Cambodia also has in place the specially-allocated Unit called: Information and Technology Office, under Anti-Human Trafficking and Juvenile Protection Department.	
	-Cambodia is part of and has participated in INTERPOL's victim identification efforts, including by contributing with images to the ICSE database, especially has recently undergone training on Victim Identification Lab organized by the INTERPOL in Bangkok, Thailand.

Description of the actions that will be undertaken and timeframe	 -Hopefully and not before long, Cambodia will have a comprehensive legislation on Anti-Cyber Crime (being drafted). -More training on the said topic have been scheduled and planned to provide to law enforcement and judiciary officials. 	

Policy target No. 2: Enhancing efforts to investigate cases of child sexual abuse online and to identify and prosecute offenders

Operational Goal:	Establish the necessary framework for the criminalization of child sexual abuse online and the effective prosecution of offenders, with the objective of enhancing efforts to investigate and prosecute offenders	
Operational Goal:	Improve the joint efforts of law enforcement authorities across Global Alliance countries to investigate and prosecute child sexual abuse online	
	Actions ALREADY UNDERTAKEN	
Description of the actions already undertaken	-Cambodia has been participating in and been supporting existing international law enforcement efforts as member of the Virtual Global Task Force and other forum such HSU(Heads of Specialist Units Meetings) among ASEAN Member Country, Bali Process aimed at information exchange and sharing, and especially operational issues.	
	-Attended joint training of investigators on online investigation organized by UNODC in collaboration with ICMEC and participated by Cambodia, Laos PDR, Thailand and Vietnam.	
	-Cambodia, as a member of the Global Alliance Against Child Sexual Abuse Online, has got ready to give our full support to international law enforcement investigations among Global Alliance countries and other countries outside in achieving the said goals aimed at dismantling networks of child sex offenders online.	
	-Cambodia has in place, since 2002, the Department of Anti-Human Trafficking and Juvenile Protection, under which a Specialist Office called "Information and Technology Office was created" to combat child sexual abuse online. But training need is badly required.	
	-To combat the growing problems of Trafficking in Persons, People Smuggling, and all kinds of Sexual Exploitation, The Royal Government of Cambodia is to establish a Committee call "National Committee for Leading the Suppression of Human Trafficking, People Smuggling, Labor Exploitation of Human Beings and Sexual Exploitation of Women and Children, both online and offline. The Committee is headed by Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Ministry of Interior, and is composed of relevant Governmental Ministers, Secretaries of State serving as Deputies and Members, Including National Police and Military Police. Under this committee there is Secretariat, under which 07 Working Groups were also created with a mix-up of composition from relevant Governmental Ministries and representatives from IGOs and NGOs serving as deputies of each of the 07 Working Groups.	
	Recently, Anti-Cyber Crime Unit (ACCU) has been established under supervision of Criminal Investigation Department, the ACCU will operate more focus on investigation cyber crime or cyber attack.

Operational Goal:	Share best practices among Global Alliance countries for effective strategies to inform the public about the risks posed by online, self-exploitative conduct in order to reduce the production of new child pornography		
	Actions ALREADY UNDERTAKEN		
Description of the actions already undertaken	-Awareness raising materials on dangers of going online and how to go safe online have been subsequently produced and disseminated to target group, especially young children, including parents on how to admonish and monitor their children while going online at home.

Policy target No. 4: Reducing as much as possible the availability of child pornography online and reducing as much as possible the re-victimization of children whose sexual abuse is depicted

Operational Goal: Operational Goal:	Encourage participation by the private sector in identifying and removing known child pornography material located in the relevant State, including increasing as much as possible the volume of system data examined for child pornography images. Increase the speed of notice and takedown procedures as much as possible without jeopardizing criminal investigation	
	Actions ALREADY UNDERTAKEN	
Description of the actions already undertaken	-State-Private Sector Partnership in this field was already in place in Cambodia.	
	-Host of meetings have been held to discuss about the issue between government officials concerned and private sector, especially the ISPs and telephone companies. The aims of the meeting are to exchange information and experiences, and to raise awareness the dangers and the criminal nature, its severity of the child sexual abuse online to private sector doing businesses involving this area.	
	-A series of Hotlines and Child help lines have been installed, by both Government and NGOs, and are operational across Cambodia to report any incidents, so that necessary actions be taken in this regard.	
	-Private sector, whose businesses as ISPs, are constantly advised and promptly required to closely monitor and immediately report any suspicious activities involving child sexual abuse online to concerning law enforcement authorities.
