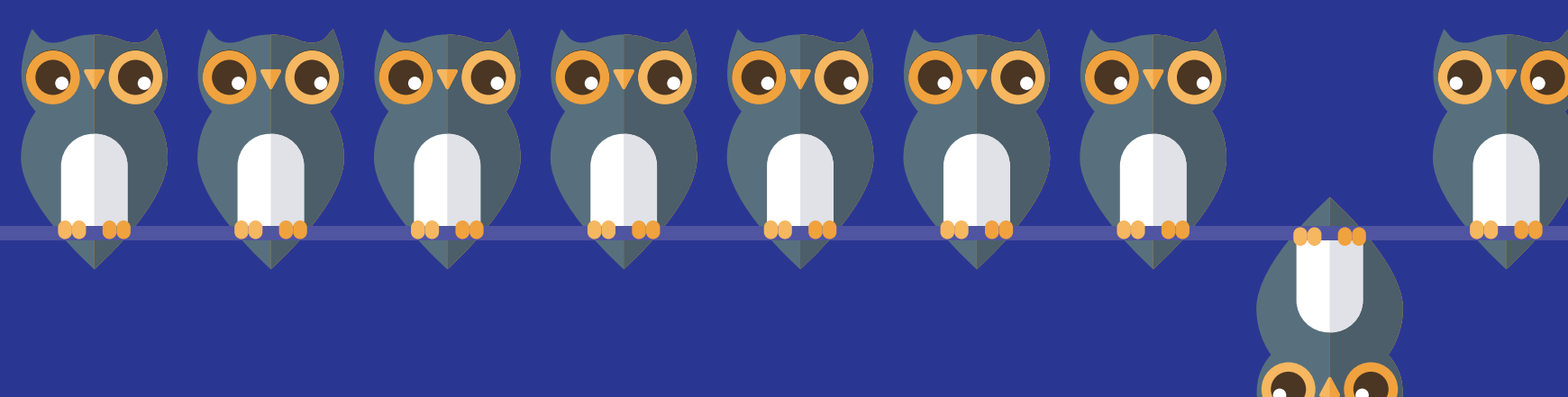
Lesson 1

Schools should transparently communicate about prevention work but not fuel polarisation



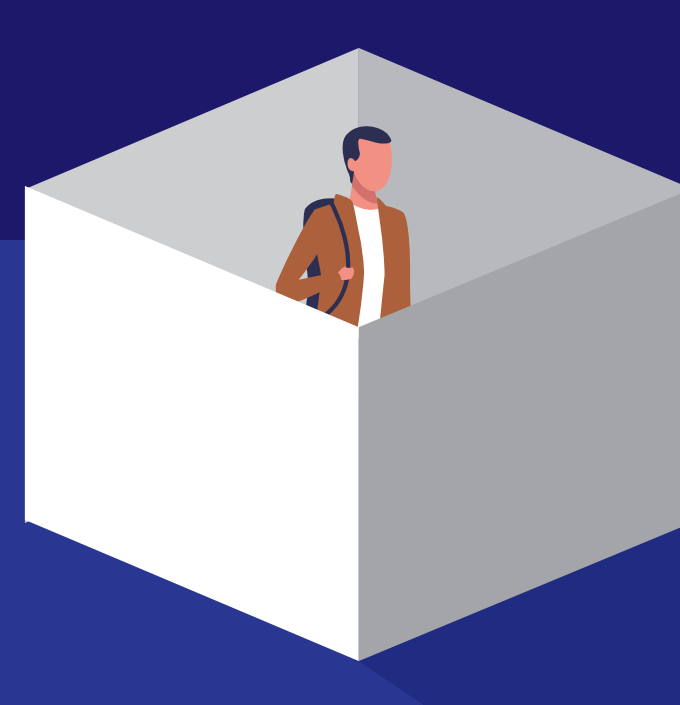
Lesson 5

Teachers should enhance their capabilities: engaging in difficult conversations, reflecting on own prejudices, offering alternatives and paying attention to those who feel left out



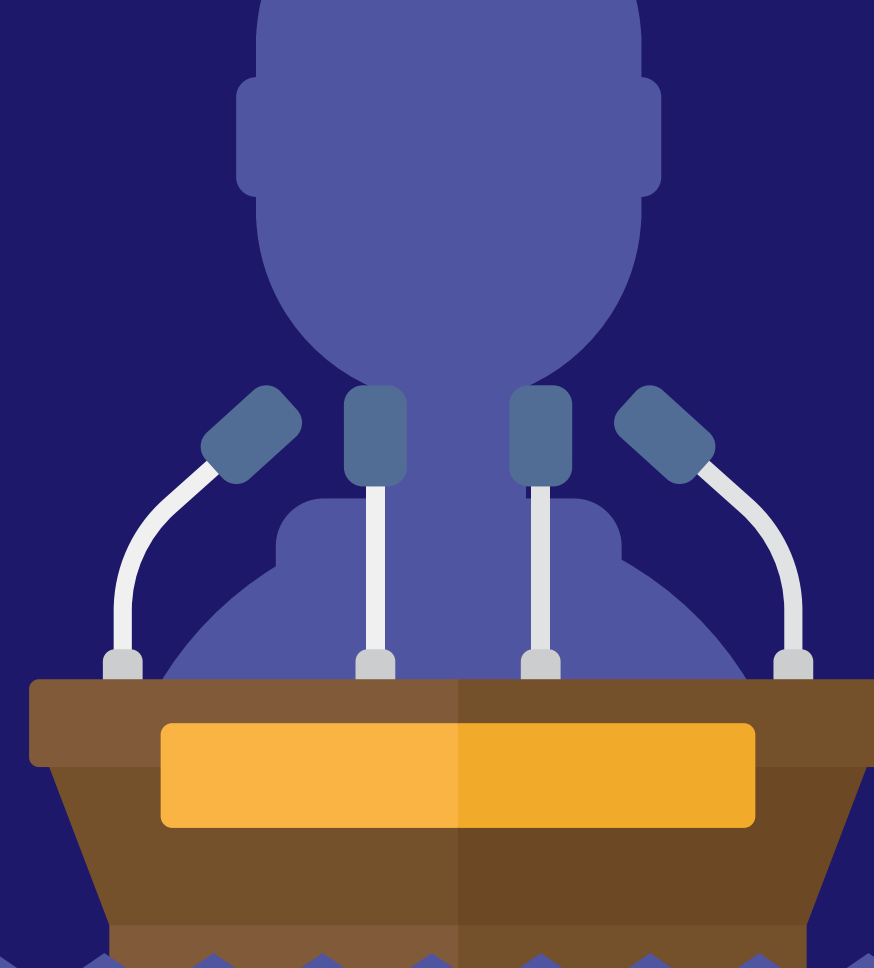

Students should hear testimonials from victims of terrorism and former extremists



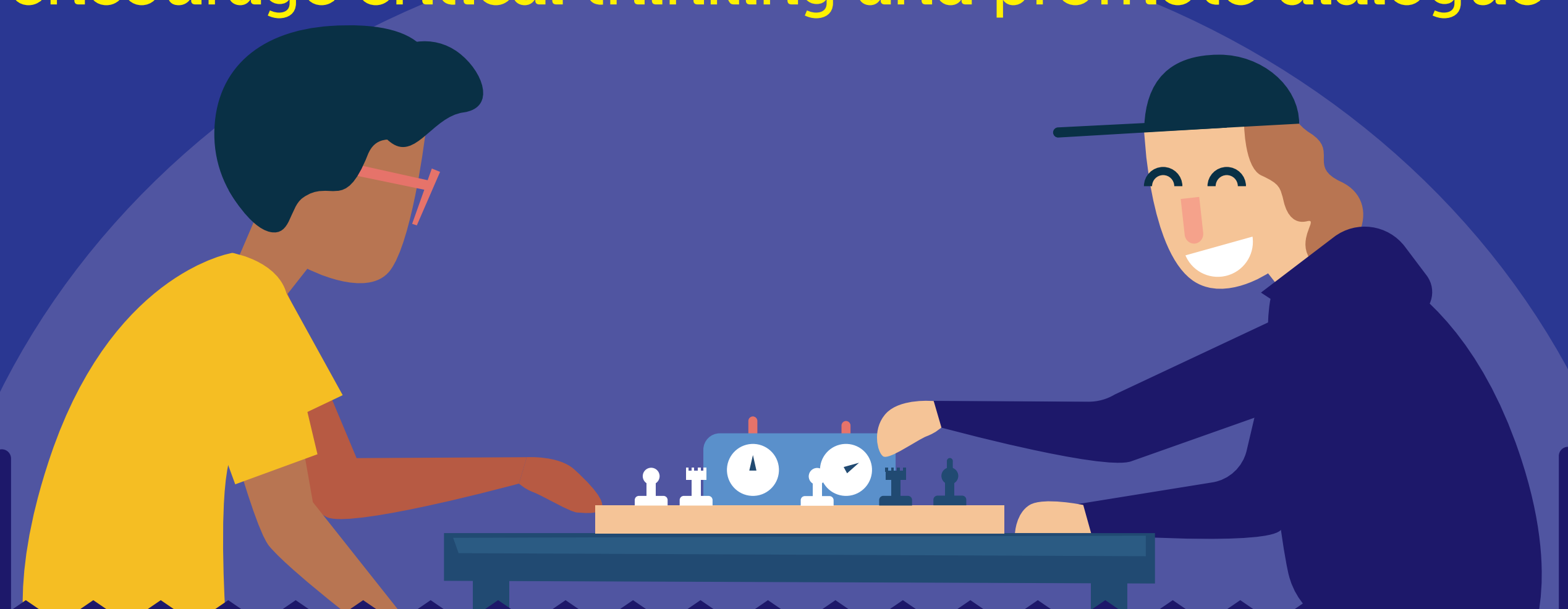
Lesson 9
