'Respect! – Against hate speech online and locally' wants to ensure that politically motivated threats, racist insults and hate speech on the internet are not accepted unchallenged. When reports come in, it checks whether any laws have been violated and then takes further action and cooperates with local police and the Federal Criminal Office in Germany. In addition, it reports to the platform operator criminal entries that constitute hate speech, insult, slander or defamation and demands their deletion. It also offers consultation for victims and reporters.

The project started in 2017 very small within the local police station, then we got reports from the whole state of Baden-Württemberg. So we started cooperating with the state criminal office and the state public prosecutor of Baden-Württemberg.

We received the evaluation of the criminal office that 91 % of our legal proceedings in 2021 were correct and successful.

Since February 2022 we are in a direct cooperation with the federal criminal office and getting reports from all states in Germany. There our reports are being evaluated monthly with a success rate of 89 %.

In 2022 the Bavarian state government wanted to extend the reporting and consulting offer to the societies in Bavaria, so that we are receiving funding also from the Bavarian state government.
