





Total Number of relocation transfers from Greece per month


November 2015 - June 2016


Bi-monthly number of Assisted Voluntary Returns from Greece





Total reception capacity in Greece







Number of arrivals 01/10/2016 - 11/7/2016






B2. End the loss of lives in the Aegean Sea







Total number of Asylum Interviews since 20/3/16




