Assisted Voluntary Return and Reintegration

third-country nationals

assisted in the return to their country of origin including the facilitation of the acquisition of emergency travel documents.

assisted with livelihood support as reintegration assistance.

Awareness Raising Campaign

vulnerable migrants and refugees
reached through outreach activities to inform migrants of available assistance, safe migration and asylum information.

Capacity Building

law enforcement officers

trained in Lower Sahel including the northern border with Libya such as Tibesti and Bourkou.

training guide

produced including the mapping of national and local legislative and institutional Chadian frameworks on services provision to migrants as well as identification, referral and protection mechanism for vulnerable migrants.

Child Protection

96 service providers trained on case management and/or support for children on the move

reunified with their families or placed in family-based care or appropriate alternative services; received protective services.

Direct Assistance

received direct assistance including accommodation, food, water, non-food items. and tailored protection assistance.

vulnerable migrants

268 who experienced complex protection concerns received tailored protection services consisting of psychosocial support, counselling, and referral to medical facilities.
