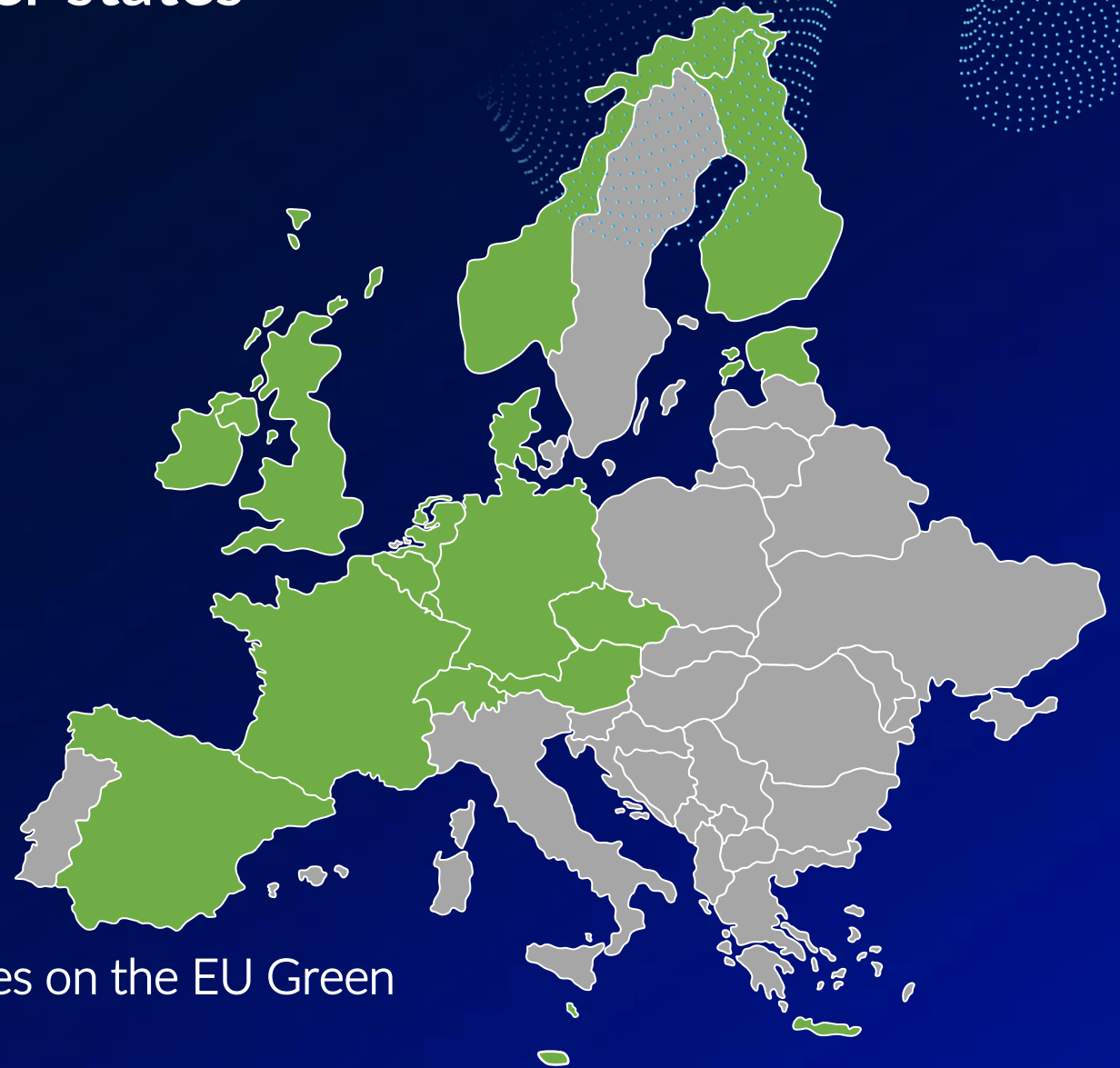

A comprehensive approach to the implementation of EU Green Deal measures in LEAs, focusing on:

**Green Mobility:** Transition to alternative fuel vehicles to comply with the EU's directive to end internal combustion engine vehicles by 2035.

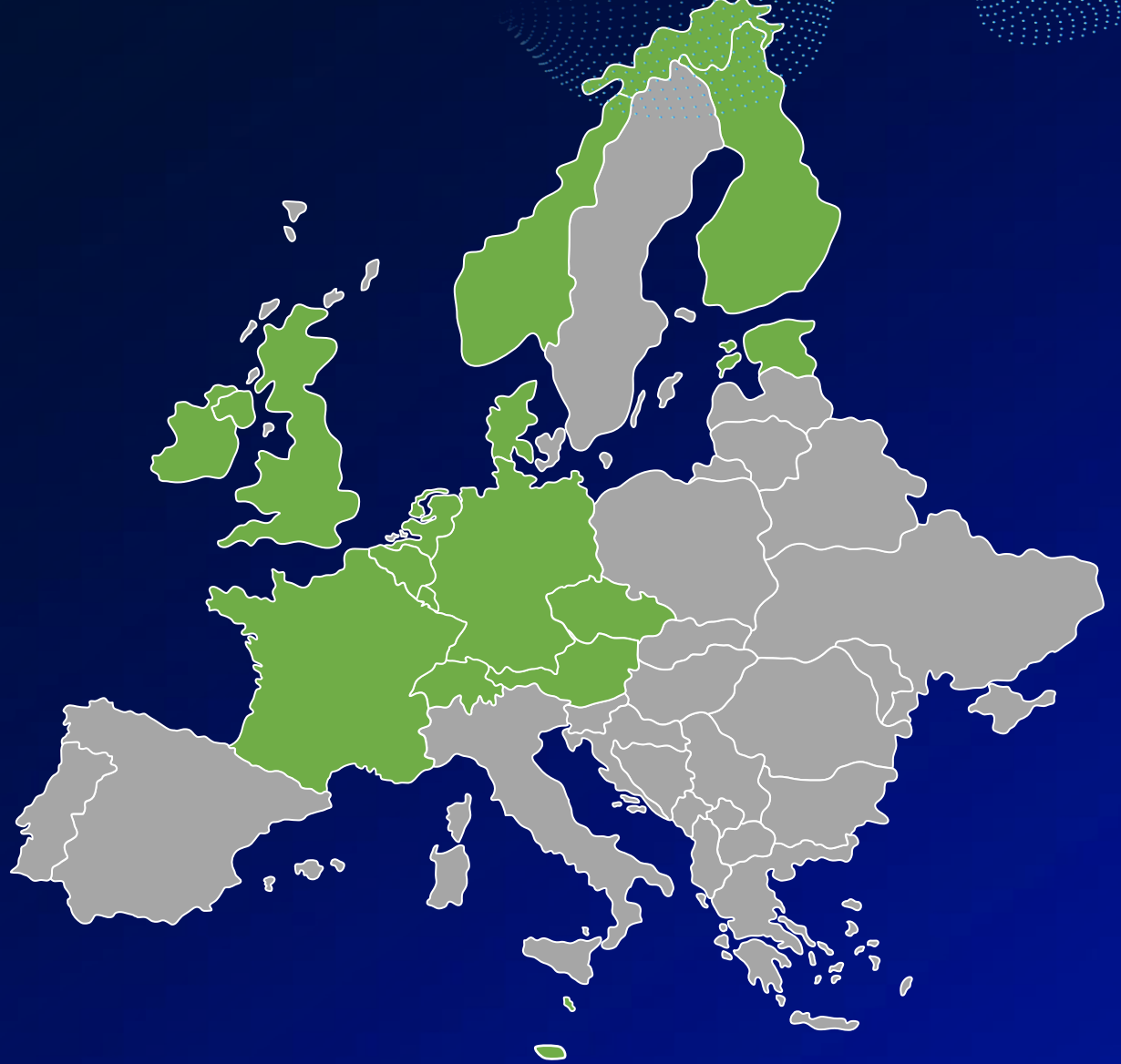
**Green Police Buildings:** Enhancing energy efficiency through EU regulations on insulation and photovoltaics, sharing best practices for building management, and implementing energy management systems to achieve emission-free police buildings by 2050.

**Green Ways of Working:** Developing a network of police experts to exchange expertise in material and logistical processes, adopting new technologies for logistics security, and streamlining equipment distribution to enhance logistical readiness and adopt green logistic processes – implementation of waste management.

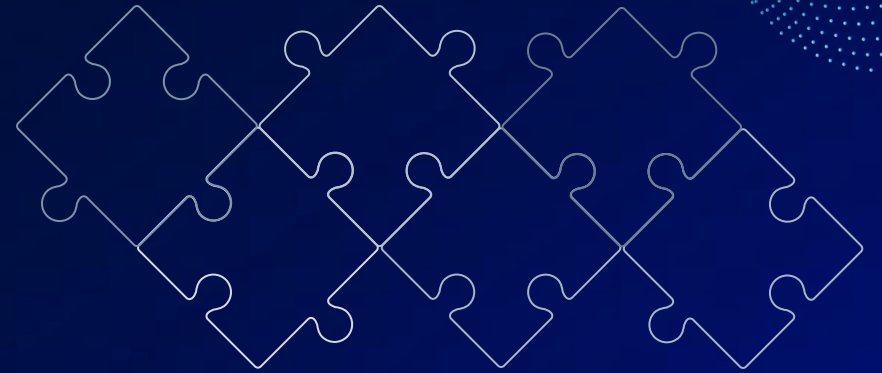


Close cooperation among LEAs (universities and ACEA)
