During the reporting period the number of reported cases of child sexual abuse online has increased. In 2013, 4 cases of children misuse in pornography have been reported including the cases of exposure to pornographic material.

Kosovo Police Directory of Community Policing and Prevention together with the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology in cooperation and support from the OSCE Mission in Kosovo is implementing a project aiming to increase the awareness among the pupils in the pre-university institutions on various fields such as: Juvenile Delinquency, Child exploitation/missuses, Drugs and other negative phenomenon's, Traffic safety, Cyber-crime and misuse of the online social networks and Human trafficking,

Based on the project objectives and activities, this project is going to be accredited and certified by MEST and will be launched in pre-university institutions in the beginning of September initially in Fushë Kosova municipality as a pilot project.

KP, MEST and the OSCE Mission in Kosovo have been implemented three out of four training sessions in training representatives from different institutions mainly people from MEST, Schools, KP to prepare them not only to lecture before the pupils but also to cascade the training to other people in the future.

This project/programme is highly assessed by the KP, MEST and the OSCE Mission in Kosovo because through the awareness of the pupils and the school personnel about various negative behaviours and phenomenon's the operational goal of the Global Alliance will be fulfilled
