

How does the EU support Member States and Partner Countries on migration?

ACTIONS IN EU MEMBER STATES



Providing operational support including through the European Union Agency for Asylum (EUAA) to ensure fast and efficient asylum procedures



Supporting relocations of people from one EU country to another on a voluntary basis



Funding to improve reception conditions, provide medial care and facilitate integration



ACTIONS ON BORDER MANAGEMENT

Operational support by Frontex on border control, including border surveillance and checks at land, sea and air





Supporting the use of common IT systems and EUROSUR to strengthen situational awareness



Funding for technical infrastructure, equipment, training and expert support



ACTIONS WITH PARTNER COUNTRIES



Reinforcing partner countries' capacities on migration management and governance, including management of their borders



Supporting partner countries' capacities to fight against migrant smugglers and human trafficking networks



Protecting refugees and migrants in need of protection, and supporting host countries



Supporting partner countries in building a sustainable return system, cooperation on assisted voluntary returns of third country nationals and reintegration of returnees in their country of origin





Supporting well-managed legal migration pathways, resettlement, complementary legal pathways for protection, labour mobility. Including through Talent Partnerships and building economic opportunities and addressing root causes of irregular migration
