Decrease in resources

- Scarcity of water supply
- Loss of arable and grazing areas
- Loss of fishing zones
- Biodiversity

Massive migrations

2,7 million people

BOKO HARAM

WHO ARE THEY?

- Nonviolent organization to a militant faction
- Islamic State West Africa Province (ISWAP)

PURPOSE

- Opposing to Western education ('Boko' in Hausa), considered sinful or prohibited ('Haram' in Arabic),
- Purifying society from Western influences, promoting Sharia law.

Lake Chad (2019-Present)

- 20% Increase in Attacks
- 30% Increase in Victims
