Areas of Intervention

Assisted Voluntary Return and Reintegration

assisted in their return and linked-up with IOM offices in countries of origin

Awareness Raising Campaign

16 initiatives among key actors involved in assisting regular migrants; and 3 awareness raising initiatives among the sheikhs and religious leaders on children' rights and children' protection.

5K vulnerable migrants and refugees reached by evidence-based information on safe migration/asylum information

Capacity Building

from CSOs, NGOs, media, and government officials received trainings on asylum and refugee issues.

training program

developed on the new counter trafficking and counter smuggling bills

Child Protection

396 service providers trained on case management and/or support for children on the move.

tools and procedures

developed for legal processes of the identification, certification and monitoring of foster families, and for the placement of children.

7.8K children received protective services, or assisted with NFIs and food items, including 912 receiving humanitarian assistance after the flooding of August 2019.

workshops

held on to counter trafficking and promote the foster family's initiative; 1 training program has been developed.
