 - ⁽³⁾ For information only: Passports issued by ECOWAS are valid for travel among ECOWAS countries. Passports issued by Member States of ECOWAS as national passports, mentioning ECOWAS on the front page, are not concerned.
 - ⁽⁴⁾ Issued to members and servants of the European Union institutions and, in exceptional circumstances, to special applicants in accordance with Council Regulation (EU) No 1417/ 2013 of 17 December 2013.
 - ⁽⁵⁾ Valid for a single journey only.
 - ⁽⁶⁾ For information only: Interpol issues the Interpol passport and the Interpol identity card which are not travel documents but are used together with a national valid travel document. They are issued to ease border crossing in accordance with a possibly existing visa facilitation agreement between INTERPOL and the country concerned.
 - ⁽⁷⁾ For information only: Passports issued by MERCOSUR are valid for travel among MERCOSUR countries. Passports issued by Member States of MERCOSUR as national passports, mentioning MERCOSUR on the front page, are not concerned. Both acronyms MERCOSUR and MERCOSUL are correct. They stand for 'Mercado Común del Sur' in Spanish and 'Mercado Comum do Sul' in Portuguese, respectively.
 - ⁽⁸⁾ Issued to American and Canadian soldiers stationed in Europe combined with a leave order.
 - ⁽⁹⁾ For information only: Passports issued by OAS are valid for travel among OAS countries.
